

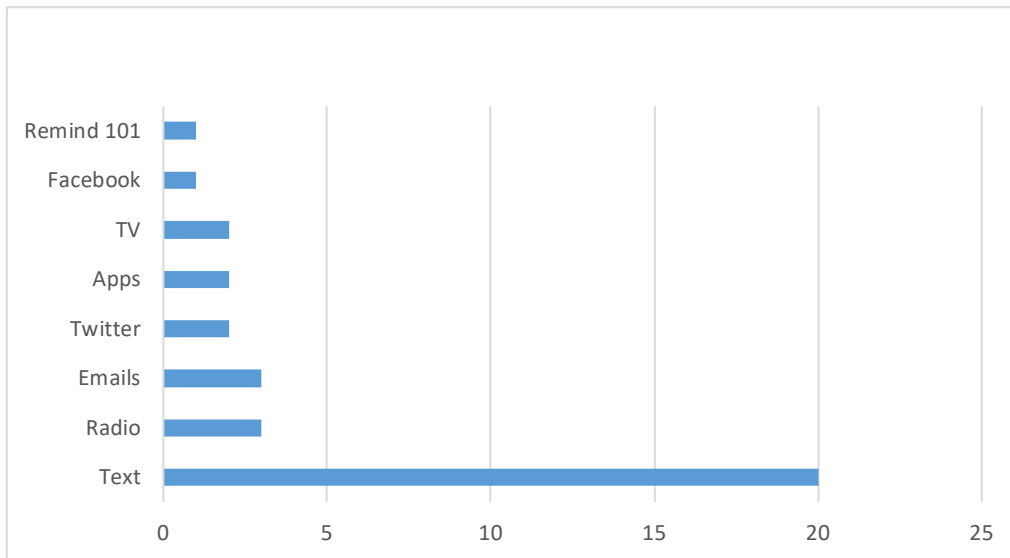
Infrastructure

Reviewing existing local drainage!! Flooding streets from small rains	Get rid of or modify the wall on I-10 (x2)

Drainage	Extend Comite Diversion if ever done to Amite River & pumping station
Starting within the city & working outward	Retention / detention ponds placed in parks
Drainage improvements impacting greatest number of residents and nursing homes	Culverts along all major streets
Investigate state wide flood control for potential project funding

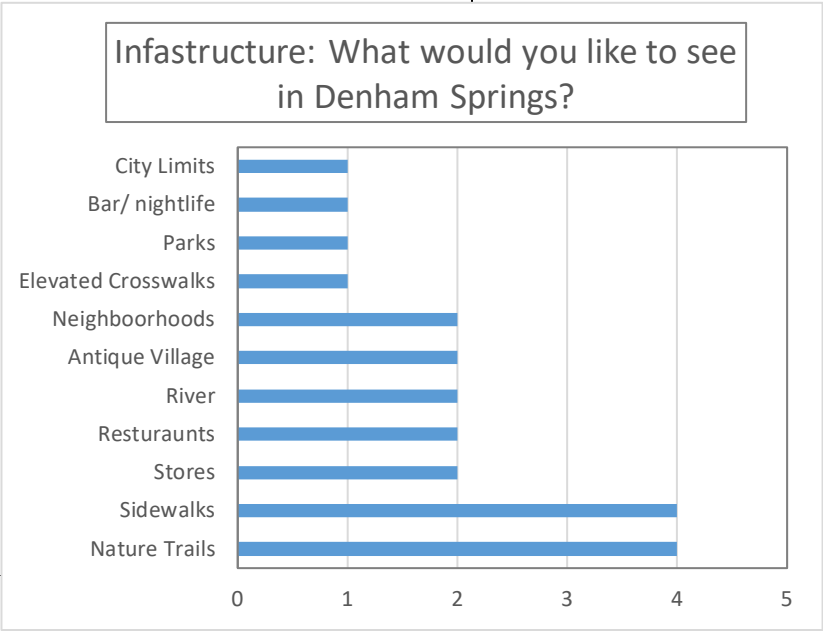
